In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 hereafter referred to as GDPR, we inform you that:

- 1) The administrator of your personal data is the University of Gdansk with its seat in (80-309) Gdansk, 8 Jana Bażyńskiego Street.
- 2) The Administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted at telephone number (58) 523 31 30 or e-mail address: iod@ug.edu.pl. The Data Protection Officer can be contacted in all matters concerning the processing of personal data and the exercise of rights related to the processing of personal data.
- 3) Your personal data will be processed in order to carry out the recruitment process for the position of a scholarship holder at the Faculty of Mathematics, Physics and Informatics University of Gdańsk within the project Sonata 16 "Symmetries and entanglement in quantum circuits" financed from the funds of the National Science Centre (Poland) and in the case of positive conclusion of the recruitment process also for the purposes connected with the realisation and financing of a scientific scholarship within the project.
- 4) The legal basis for the processing of your personal data for the purposes of recruitment is Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR consent of the data subject, and in the case of scholarship status also Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party, or to take action at the request of the data subject before entering into a contract.
- 5) Your personal data will be processed on behalf of the controller by authorised staff solely for the purposes referred to in point 3.
- 6) Your personal data will not be shared with external entities, except in cases provided by law. Moreover, recipients of your personal data can be Managing, Accounting, Intermediate Bodies, Monitoring, Controlling, Implementing or Project Partners.
